

## Collections with no collections

Looking at the recent bank statement, I notice that there are some new standing orders. Thank you to those who have taken new standing orders: it is extremely helpful at a time when our income is diminished but our expenditure is largely not. Thank you also to those who paid the Parish, either for general or Easter collections, through the Diocesan facility. We have received £300 through this route.

Can we encourage people who do not have standing orders at present to take them out. To do so, we can provide a form to complete and send to your bank, but your bank probably has a form available on line. The bank details are:

If your bank has a problem with the length of the name, try "Cthlc Chrch of St Agstne of cn". Don't forget to include your name in the reference so that we can link your contribution to the Gift Aid Declaration.

If you don't want to take out a standing order, you can still pay directly to the Parish's bank account with the same details as above. Also, the Diocese has a facility to pay parishes collections but it does not pay until the end of each month, so a direct payment is better for us.

We are still hoping to run a 200 Club this year and have collected money for 25 shares at the moment.
